<u>CGHS Wellness Centre Jammu:</u> Digitization of the Centre was pursued and completed during the year

<u>Demand of New or Extension Centre of CGHS at Srinagar</u>: This was pursued and it is now under active consideration of Ministry of Health & FW, Gol.

Establishment of Day Care Centre for Older Persons: A dream project of the Association to establish a Day Care Centre for Older Persons has taken shape during the period 2015-16. It is conveniently located opposite CGHS Wellness Centre at Exhibition Ground Complex, Jammu. The Centre is being improved further with the needed amenities. A Care Taker has been engaged on an honorarium basis and the members are requested to avail the facility, particularly while waiting for getting medicine supplies from the CGHS Dispensary.

Launching of Website of the Association: For propagation and dissemination of information on activities of the Association, a Website was designed, registered during June. September, 2015. It was launched formally on 15th September, 2015. The concept of the website was deliberated first in the weekly meeting of 15th June, 2015 and work on the proposal started soon after. The website is updated on regular basis, uploading weekly updates and minutes, along with latest Government Orders/Office Memoranda. <u>Weekly Talks</u>: This is yet another novel activity initiated by the Association during the year. Member Resource Persons are invited to give talks on informative topics, supported by power point presentations. The programme has added further the quality and content of the Weekly Meetings by the Association. Number of members attending weekly meetings has gone up appreciably on account of such value additions in the meetings.

Registered Membership:

30 new members joined the Association during the year. Number of Registered Members as on March, 2016 stands at 278 vis-avis 101 in March, 2011.

Media Coverage of Activities:

The welfare activities of the Association are given wide publicity through electronic and print media coverage. This is done for general awareness and for reaching out the stakeholders, including those residing in far off nooks and corners of the State. The

Weekly Meetings:

- The Association continued to hold weekly meetings every Monday morning at 10.30 & 11.00 hrs. (Summer & Winter timing) at its Jammu Olympic Association Building Parade Ground Jammu 180001 office; in pursuance of its activities. It is quite encouraging to see that the number of members attending weekly meetings has improved appreciably. Discussions/interactive consultations were held in the meetings as per agenda with recording of the minutes and registration of attendance of the members present in the Minutes Register maintained by the Association.
- 49 nos. of weekly meetings were held during the period to discuss and resolve various problems of the pensioners in Implementation of Webbased Pensionersq Portalq a Mission Mode Project under National e-Governance Plan (NeGP). Only 2 weekly meetings scheduled for 3rd August and 9th November, 2015 had to be cancelled on account of Bandh Call and Inclement Weather on the respective dates.
- The number of members who attended weekly meetings ranged generally between 25 and 35. Maximun number of 43 members attended the weekly meeting held on 18th January, 2016.
- Srinagar Branch: Weekly meetings were held regularly at Srinagar Office by the members stationed there. Issues pertaining to accommodation, CGHS Wellness Centre at Srinagar were taken up, besides day to day matters. International Day for Older persons was celebrated by paying visit to very senior pensioners who due to advanced age cannot attend weekly meetings. A couple of picnics were also organized by the members for the well being and entertainment of the pensioners.

Honouring Senior Members: At the Event of 20th AGM on 25.4.2015 *Sarv Sreshth Vrishth Nagrik Award*: In pursuance of the high traditions of the Association, one very senior member Shri Dwarka Nath Gupta, IAS (1915 born) was honoured with *Sarv Sreshth Vrishth Nagrik Award* on attaining 100 years of age.

Jeishth Vrishth Nagrik: Five senior members of the Organization; S/Shri M.M.Munshi GSI, S.C.Gupta DAD, N.L.Bakshi IAS, Sujjan Singh IFS & Swami Raj Sharma IAS were honoured as **Jeyshth Vrishth Nagrik** on attaining 80 years age with presentation of mementoes by the Chief Guest on 20th AGM on 25th April, 2015.

The function was attended by a large number of Association Members and special invitees from various Organizations of State Government pensioners; besides eminent social activists.

Registration of Grievances:

Ten Numbers of fresh Pensionersq Grievances were registered in Centralized Pension Grievances Redress And Monitoring System (CPENGRAMS) online in the PensionersqPortal by the Association during the period under report and older grievances pursued. Out of this, 9 cases were resolved.

Voluntary Services by the Association:

- The Association has been serving the central pensioners in matters of their pension dues, refixation of pension as per Sixth CPC recommendations and subsequent O.M.s, pension arrears, timely release of Dearness Relief (DR), revised Fixed Medical Allowance and related matters. It is observed that many cases are still there where the pensioners are not getting their rightful dues as per entitlement; especially those who retired long back in eighties or seventies.
- The services of the Association are available not only to the registered members, but also to the pensioners who are not registered with CGPWA.
- <u>Free Medical Camp on World Hypertension Day (Under SANKALP):</u> On the occasion of World Hypertension Day on 17th May, 2015; a Free Cardiac Disease Detection Camp was organized by the Association at CGHS Wellness Centre Jammu. More than 120 patients were examined by a team of Specialists led by Dr. Sushil K. Sharma, HoD Cardiology, Government Medical College Jammu.
