## <u>Activities of Central Government Pensioners' Welfare Association,</u> **J&K**,

## Highlights of 2 Weeks Ending November 30, 2015:

- Power Point Presentation on 7CPC Recommendations: Seventh Central Pay Commission which was constituted on 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2014 submitted its report to the Finance Minister, Government of India on 19<sup>th</sup> November, 2015.
- Shri J.K.Vaid, Retd. Director, Geological Survey of India made a Power Point Presentation on 7CPC Recommendation in the Weekly Talk on 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2015 after going through 898 page report uploaded by the Gol. An 18 Level Pay Matrix has been recommended by the Commission which will replace Pay Bands of 6CPC.
- Pension for Pre-1.1.2016 pensioners will be calculated as under:
- 1. All personnel will be first fixed in the pay matrix at entry level. This
  amount shall be raised by adding number of increments earned in
  that level while in service, @ 3%. 50% of the amount so arrived at
  shall be the revised pension. OR
- 2. 6CPC Pension x 2.57; whichever is beneficial.
- The Pay Commission has also recommended that the Pay Matrix may be revised periodically without waiting for 10 long years for next pay commission recommendations.
- In the Weekly Meeting of 30.11.2015, Shri Vaid elaborated further the 7CPC recommendations which would be implemented from 1.1.2016 after issuance of Govt. Orders in this regard.



- Weekly Talk by Shri V.P.Sharma, Retd. Director GSI (Patron of the Association) on 30<sup>th</sup> Nov. on Climate Change & Related Issues: Shri Sharma gave an informative talk on the burning issues related to climate change, environmental degradation, Carbon Foot Prints and need for Clean Energy such as solar energy, wind energy and nuclear energy; instead of fossil fuel energy which is a great pollutant and producing Green House Gases. In India, presently, we produce 70% of power generated by fossil fuel, mainly coal. There was good interaction on the topic and Shri Nasar Khan, IGP (Retd) also expressed his views on cleanliness and preservation of environment.
- <u>Birthday Celebrations of Shri Y.S.Narsinghia, IFS (Retd):</u> Birthday Event of Narsinghia was celebrated on 23th Nov, 2015 with presentation of bouquet and photographs.
