

Record Note of meeting of 2nd February, 2026

Twenty-eight members attended.

The General Secretary apprised the members about the progress on the following agenda point and discussion followed up.

1. Transfer of Thanger Land to CGHS: The GS informed the meeting that contrary to the information shared by the Secretary H&ME, the file is still with the Law Deptt. According to the Law Secretary, the file has been sent to the HCM for approval. The Law Deptt has supported the case.
2. More CGHS WC in JK Govt: - The GS informed that apart from ten major Hospitals, primarily attached with the GMCs, the CS has reportedly impressed upon the H&ME to identify more hospitals in J&K for empanelment with CGHS where the pensioners especially the eligible JK Pensioners can take benefit of this facility. However, the CGHS has not yet initiated a process for deployment of requisite staff and Doctors at these places.
3. Formal Allotment Order for Wazarat Road office accommodation: - The GS informed that he has no feedback on this issue as Shri Shaleen Kabra did not respond to his calls.
4. Paripoorna Mediclaim Ayush Bima for Pensioners: - Since it is optional, no Association has shown any interest in it. Our Association will oppose it as and when discussion will be taken up at SCOVA or at any other forum.
5. 77th Republic Day celebration: - A grand Function was organised at Wazarat Road Office premises. About 60 members attended the ceremony. The President, Shri Kuldeep Khoda unfurled the flag. Dr Ashok Bhan conducted a 15-minute event of 'mass singing' of some patriotic popular songs which infused a nationalistic fervour. The Birthday ceremony was also clubbed with the R-day function and eight veterans born in the month of January were felicitated.
6. Follow-up action on three pending issues by CS: - Details of two pending issues- Thanger land and formal allotment are recorded above. Third issue of crediting pension in JKB on a fixed date irrespective of the day being Bank holiday could not be followed up.
7. Timely Supply of medicines: - there is no improvement in this matter even though I/C of both WCs have been repeatedly requested for action.

8. Meeting with Representatives of HCO:- Dr Shivali Sharma has informed that as per instructions of the DG CGHS, the Hospitals are busy in completing formalities of re-empanelment, the requested meeting will be convened after completion of this process.

9. K P Sabha Accommodation: The GS informed that the AD CGHS Chd has again been persuaded to seek approval from the competent authority for signing the rent deed. He has promised to send an e-file to Director CGHS soon under intimation to us.

10. Delay in settling MRCs: - Regrettably, there is no improvement on this issue. However, during GS' talk with AD Chd, he has sought a list of pending cases. A request has been made in the WA Group by the GS to share with him their pending MRCs case of more than six months so that a comprehensive list is sent to him.

11. Empanelment of AIIMS: - The new Director AIIMS, Vijaypur will be approached for initiating the process of empanelment. He will be shared with the Govt statement that all AIIMS will be empanelled with CGHS.

12. Meeting of Advisory Committee for WC-1: - It was held after the Monday meeting. Dr Shahid has not yet shared in the WA group or otherwise the formal minutes of the meeting. He will be reminded about it.

13. Next Meeting: The next meeting will be held on 23rd February. The birthday of veterans born in the month of Feb. will be felicitated. However, Dr Sudarshan Kumar celebrated his birthday which was on 2nd Feb and hosted a gala party. Members felicitated him.

14. Contributory Lunch: The monthly contributory lunch will be held on 28th Feb, 2026
